Where Men Are Thriving

Thailand:

A top choice for men craving peace and a low cost of living. Thailand offers **digital nomad visas**, strong expat communities, and a culture that still values traditional roles all in a stunning setting with world-class food.

Launched July 15, 2024, the **DTV** is designed specifically for remote workers, freelancers and digital nomads

Valid for 5 years with multiple entries, up to 180 days per stay, extendable once each entry

Eligibility: remote income from abroad; may need proof like employment contracts or at least 500,000 THB in savings

Restrictions: You can work remotely for foreign employers but cannot work for Thai companies without a separate work permit



Bangkok, Thailand

Colombia:

A vibrant, romantic and affordable choice. Colombia offers a **digital nomad visa** that lets you work remotely while immersing yourself in Latin culture.

Digital Nomad Visa Launched: officially available since 2022, known as the “Visa V for Digital Nomads

Valid for up to 2 years, ideal for settling into places like **Medellín** or **Bogotá**

Eligibility: proof of remote work for a foreign company, foreign income (typically ~3× Colombia’s minimum wage – around USD 684–995/month), health insurance, valid passport

Restrictions: cannot work for Colombian companies; must earn from outside the country



Bogotá, Colombia

Portugal:

Stable, scenic and welcoming. Portugal offers visa options for both nomads and passive-income holders, making it ideal for long-term relocation.

Digital Nomad Visa (D8): Minimum €3,280/month; savings around €9,840

D7 Passive-Income Visa: (also fits nomads with passive income): Minimum €870/month + savings of €10,440; must show proof of accommodation

Eligibility: proof of remote work for a foreign company, foreign income (typically ~3× Colombia's minimum wage – around USD 684–995/month), health insurance, valid passport

Restrictions & Notes: D8 requires a Portuguese tax ID (NIF), clean criminal record, accommodation proof, health insurance. Renewals require physical presence (16/28 months in total)
